forthwith without further notice.

DIRECTIONS FOR ACKNOWLEDGING SERVICE

The Defendant must acknowledge service in person or by a solicitor by handing in the accompanying form, duly
completed, at the High Court Registry aforesaid.

Note: Where the writ is endorsed with or served with a statement of claim, if the Defendant acknowledges service, then unless a
summons for judgment is served on him in the meantime, he must also serve a defence on the solicitor for the Plaintiff within
14 days after the last day of the time limited for acknowledging service, otherwise judgment may be entered against him
without notice.

INDORSEMENT OF CLAIM

The Plaintiffs', as trustees of the Fiji Muslim League ("the League"), a religious body duly registered under the Registration of Religious Bodies Act claim against the Defendants as follows:

1. An Order that within 3 hours of service of this Order, the first Defendant disband and remove any matter concerning the Plaintiffs as trustees of the Fiji Muslim League, the Fiji Muslim League and the Judiciary of Fiji from his website: <http://www.halalforallah.com/>
2. An Order that the first Defendant be restrained from placing any further material on any website or maintaining any website having derogatory material published against the Judiciary of Fiji and the Plaintiffs as trustees of the Fiji Muslim League and the Fiji Muslim League.
3. An Order that the first Defendant be restrained from publishing any defamatory or false material likely to cause pecuniary damages to the Plaintiffs in any form, media or medium whatsoever
4. An Order that the Defendants pay general and punitive damages for the libel contained in the Fiji Sun issue of 28 March 2013 in the Public Notice section.
5. An Order that the first Defendant pay general and punitive damages to the Plaintiff for the injurious falsehood material contained in his website: <http://www.halalforallah.com/>
6. Costs of the action on a full indemnity basis.
